Scope and Content Note

- 1 letter : [no date] : from Hotel Taube, Schruus, [i.e., Schruns] Vorarlberg, Autriche; addressed to "Dear Ernest and Dear Miss Moorhead"; begins, "Hurray for the new Review. I think its a fine thing for you both to do ...".
- 1 letter : 13 Feb 1925 : from Hotel Taube, Schreuus, Vorarlberg, Austria; begins, "Your two letters of Feb 4-5 came just as we were going up to a hut in the mts. ...".
- 1 letter : 9 Mar 1925 : begins, "Yours of March 5th in this morning but preceded by that damned fine telegram from you and Miss Moorhead.".
- 1 letter : 18 Mar [1925] : from 113 Rue Notre Dame des Champs.; begins, "On receipt of your wire I went to Man Ray who I knew had a photo of Pound.".
- 1 letter : 24 Mar [1925] : begins, "The Braucusi reproductions have just come in.".
- 1 letter : 28 Mar [1925] : begins, "Stopped at Clarkes this noon and found only one thing finished. The

Peacock prose."

· 1 letter : "Monday -- 4 pm." : begins, "You certainly can make a man feel good when you write about -- The Undefeated. Picks me up. Makes me feel its worth while working. And I need it."

· 1 letter : [no date] : begins, "We used to stop at Bellagio on Como for week ends from Milan during the war but I dont remember names of pubs."
