Abstract: The Abingdon Square Collection contains information about the development of Abingdon Square, reminiscences of area residents regarding the square, and correspondence and flyers regarding proposed alterations to traffic flow in the area. An early article about the square dates from 1929, the remainder of the materials are dated between 1958 and 1981. Abingdon Square Park, created in 1836, is located in Greenwich Village in New York City, and is one of the City's oldest parks.
