**Abstract:** Diary, June 8, 1778 to April 6, 1779, kept on a march from a point forty miles from Berwick, Maine, to Fishkill and West Point, New York, passing through Newmarket, N. H.; Haverhill, Concord, Worcester, and Springfield, Mass.; Simsbury and Kent, Conn. Brief entries for weather, illness, guard duty, etc. Returned via Hartford and Boston. Also shoemaking and merchandise accounts, 1779-1780
