**Abstract:** Ledger kept by Hendrick Frey, Sr. and Hendrick Frey, Jr. of general merchandise accounts for settlers in Canajohary (Canajoharie), New York, including William Johnson. Frey, Sr.'s accounts (1755-1763) are recorded in Palatine German; Frey, Jr.'s accounts are recorded in English. No entries were kept during the Revolution
