**Abstract:** Diary or narrative by a British subject of a journey from August 6- September 6, 1808, from New York City to Albany by steamboat, thence overland to Niagara Falls, and returning through Ballston to Hudson, thence by packet "Experiment" to New York City. Writer describes travel accommodations, inn keepers, modes of living; effect of Jefferson's embargo on New York and Canada; Niagara Falls; forts; Indians at Buffalo, etc. Illustrated with a few pen sketches
