**Abstract:** These noncommercial sound recordings were collected by Mary Howe and primarily consist of her own compositions, in particular her vocal and chamber works. Several performances feature Mary Howe as pianist or accompanist. Additional performers include Celius Dougherty, Emerson Meyers, Mona Paulee, and William Strickland.

**Access:** Access to original items by permission only. Some items may be available as service copies. Other items which need preservation work may require advance notification for use. Refer to item descriptions in individual catalog records for more information.

## Creator History

Mary Howe (1882-1964) was an American pianist and composer. She studied music, both in Europe, and in the United States. At the Peabody Conservatory of Music, she studied composition with Gustav Strube and piano with Ernest Hutcheson. She also studied with Nadia Boulanger, Harold Randolph, and Richard Burmeister. Howe began her career by giving piano recitals and went on to become very active in the Washington D.C. musical scene. She collaborated with Friends of Music at the Library of Congress, and was a member of the board of directors of the National Symphony Orchestra, the National Federation of Music Clubs, and the National Association of Composers and Conductors. She was also one of the founders of the Association of American Women Composers. Mary Howe

composed music for the piano, piano and voice, and chamber ensembles as well as for symphonic orchestra. As an active musician she often performed her own compositions as well as works by classical composers.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The collection consists of noncommercial recordings which were collected by Mary Howe, and span her career from 1935 to 1960. Some of the earlier recordings consist of interviews broadcast on radio stations, WNBC and WNYC. The bulk of the collection consists of works for female voice and piano performed by such soloists as Margaret Barnwell, Juanita Carter, Ada MacLeish, Harriet Cohen, Enya Gonzalez, Katherine Hansel, Ina Hotzcheiter, Judith Litante, and Edma Wheelright, among others. The recordings include recitals given by Mary Howe as a piano soloist or in collaboration with numerous other musical personalities such as Hans Kindler, Celius Dougherty, Otto Luening, and Roman Totenberg. Her works, as illustrated in these holdings, were performed by numerous orchestras such as the National Capitol Parks Schola Cantorum, the National Gallery Orchestra, the National Symphony Orchestra, the Washington String Quartet, the Alberneri Trio, and the Vienna Symphony Orchestra. Howe composed seven cycles for piano and voice, many of which are included in the collection. Of her best known works, her ballet *Cards*, is included in the collection in various arrangements, as well as many of her works for voice and other ensembles. The collection includes more than three dozen songs and chamber works.
