Abstract: Humphrey Doulens was a writer affiliated with Columbia Artists' Management for many years, and under the auspices of that organization edited a mini-biography of opera singer Gladys Swarthout. The Humphrey Doulens papers consist mostly of brief notes and telegrams to Doulens pertaining to his writing career, along with his 1928 letter accepting a position with VARIETY, and two comic Christmas cards he sent to friends.
