Abstract: The Web was a weekly mystery anthology television series that aired on CBS from 1951 to 1954. The Web episodes were shot live and based on stories written by the members of the Mystery Writers of America. The Web scripts date from 1951 to 1952 and contain shooting scripts for episodes 55 through 95. The scripts are annotated to show changes made to dialogue, along with technical notes, prop notes, and the run time for individual scenes.
