Biographical Note

Arthur “Archie” Koty was born ca. 1912. He was a mid-twentieth century composer of orchestral music. He had one sister, Florence Newmark, who was an elementary school music teacher. He had one son, Ross.

Some of the music Koty composed includes: *Clarinet Polka*, *The Parrot* and *Le Secret*. Koty died May 11, 1984.

Scope and Content Note

The collection contains printed musical scores. Most music is parts of orchestral scores. In addition there is one notebook of piano music. Also included is a music book for elementary school music programs, written by Koty's sister, Florence Newmark.

The collection is lacking any personal material about Koty.
