Historical note

The New York Public Library's Public Education Program (PEP) was established in 1983 as a forum for lectures, panel discussions, interviews, and performances.

The Public Education Program was a unit of the Office of Development and Public Affairs until 1986 when it became an independent Central Administration Office. Library President Vartan Gregorian appointed David Cronin the first director. Cronin was succeeded by Elizabeth Bradley in 2000. In 2004 the Public Education Program was reorganized and its programs presented as the "Live from the NYPL" series under the direction of Paul Holdengräber.

Scope and content note

The Public Education Program recordings showcase the diverse topics covered by Library programs, including modern literature, cinema, the history of New York City, current events, and community issues. The programs included on-going lecture series on photography, the history of printing and the book arts, Jewish affairs and culture, and the Book of the Month Club's "Art and Craft" of writing series. Seasonal programs usually consisted of lectures or other events relating to a special theme, such as censorship, feminism, or U.S. foreign policy, often designed to complement Library exhibits or focus on Library collections. Well-known speakers in these recordings include Toni Morrison, Robert Caro, Alfred Kazin, Allen Ginsberg, Philip Glass, Nat Hentoff, Gore Vidal, Joyce Carol Oates, and Joan Didion.
