- Description:** The collection consist of letters to and from John Quinn, lawyer and art patron, with members of the Irish Literary Renaissance, the Irish Home Rule Movement, with English and American literary figures and with art dealers and artists of France, England and the United States. Notable correspondents include: Sir Roger Casement, Joseph Conrad, T. S. Eliot, Lady Isabella Gregory, James G. Huneker, Douglas Hyde, Augustus E. John, Gwen John, James Joyce, Maud Gonne MacBride, Walter Pach, Ezra Pound, Henri Pierre Roche, Thomas William Rolleston, George William Russell, Alfred Steiglitz, Arthur Symons, Townsend Walsh, John Butler Yeats and William Butler Yeats.
