Julian Symons was an English novelist, poet, essayist, literary critic, short-story writer, historian, and biographer.

This is a synthetic collection consisting of manuscripts, typescripts, and correspondence by and about the author. The manuscripts and typescripts consist of essays, articles, notes for work, poems, synopses, portions of novels, and lectures by the author, as well as poems and articles by Robert Conquest, Eric A.
