active and diligent Friendship in making the attestation and the Application concerning Johnson's Anecdotes ...".

• To Mr. Motherwell at Llewenny Bleach Works : 1 autograph letter third person : 12 Jan 1795 : (MISC 0274) : 1/\_ page (single sheet) : [from Denbigh] : begins, "Mr. & Mrs. Piozzi think it absolutely necessary to acquaint Mr. Motherwell that those Sheets which they bought at a very high Price -- with a wave in them like Dimilly --- thinking, as Mr. Motherwell said, that they would last for ever; are already worne out ...".
