• Three autograph signatures in account book for construction work at Castle Goring between 6 Jun 1807 and 30 Mar 1811: [signatures dated 28 Jun 1808, 16 Mar 1810, and 18 Apr 1811]: (S'ANA 0106): [from Worthing, Sussex]: authorizing payment to John Rebecca, the architect; with Rebecca's autograph signatures. The account book consists of 52 manuscript pages, in a clerical hand, within a notebook with marbled wrappers.
