English; in unknown hand, possibly that of A. or W. Galignani; responding to questions relating to the possibility of selling Hall's Voyages and Travels in Paris. Along with Hall's letter which prompted this response (B'ANA 0458a). -- 1 letter (draft): 26 Nov 1830: (B'ANA 0551b): in English; in unknown hand, possibly that of A. or W. Galignani; responding to a letter of Hall's of 17 Sep of the same year. Along with the Hall letter (B'ANA 0551a). All letters to Hall filed under "Basil Hall.".

• To William Hazlitt, writer and painter: 1 letter (draft): 15 Feb [1827]: (WH 0013b): in English; in unknown hand, probably that of A. Galignani; declining Hazlitt's offer to publish a translation of his Life of Napoleon. On p. 3 a folded lettersheet, on the first page of which is Hazlitt's offer. Filed under "Hazlitt" in the SC file.
