- To John Johnson of East Dereham, Norfolk, cousin of William Cowper, the poet: 1 autograph letter signed, "your ever sincere & affectionate Hermit": 15 Jul 1816: (MISC 4288): 1 page (single sheet): [no place]: begins, "In my immediate reply to you yesterday, by the returning post, I had not time to speak of our interesting Margaret Perowne..."; including a ten-line verse epitaph for Margaret Perowne, Johnson's housekeeper.
- · To George Nicol, bookseller and publisher: 1 autograph letter signed: 29 Jan 1792: (MISC 4028):

regarding Hayley's biography of Milton, which would be published two years later by Nicol and others as part of the Poetical Works of John Milton; also asking about their mutual friend, the poet Joseph Warton.
