- To "My Lord" : 1 autograph letter signed "B. Sarum" : 25 May 1725 : (MISC 0517) : begins, "Amongst a very great number of troublesome persons, I beg leave to be one." With loss on the top right corner of p. 2; affecting five lines of text.
