- · Autograph note attesting Shelley family provenance of scarf ring: [ca. 1962?]: (S'ANA 1070a): in ink on formerly crumpled up sheet of lined notepaper; note reads: "Old scarf pin / left me by / Auntie [Budrie?] / (Eliza Margaret Esdaile) / Possibly belonged to / Shelley & left / her by her mother / Shelley's daughter / lanthe." Housed with scarf pin; shelved with realia.
- · Autograph note authenticating Harriet Shelley's engagement ring: [ca. 1962?]: (S'ANA 1070b): in ink on an envelope; note reads: "Engagement ring / Shelley gave his / first wife Harriet / Westbrook." Housed with ring; shelved with realia.
- · Autograph note on cardboard jewelry box : [ca. 1962?] : (S'ANA 1070c) : in ink on box top; note reads: "Engagement Ring / given by Shelley to Harriet / Scarf Pin." The printing on the box lid, "Barnicott & Pearce / Taunton," has been cancelled. Box kept with ring and scarf pin; shelved with realia.
