• 14 Jun 1808 : (MISC 4393) : 1 autograph letter signed by Constance Benyon, wife of Samuel Yate Benyon, one of His Majesty's counsel : 4 pages (double sheet) : from Russell Square : with much discussion of gowns and fabrics; begins, "My journey to Brighton being deferred 'till this day week, I hope I shall have time to see all your commissions extended . . . .".

• 15 Aug 1808 : (MISC 4392) : 1 autograph letter signed by Charlotte Botfield, her sister-in-law : 2 <sup>1</sup>/\_ pages (double sheet) : from Weymouth : begins, "My dear Sister, For by that title I am now authorized to call you . . ."; with a letter from Beriah Botfield to William Withering on pages 3-4 of the double sheet.

· 2 Sep 1808 : (MISC 4390) : 1 autograph letter signed by "L. Lee" : 4 pages (double sheet) : from

Swanage House near Wareham, Dorsetsh[ire] : with advice on married life; begins, "I have long earnestly wished to transmit the hearty & sincere congratulations of Mr Lee, myself & family . . . .".

• 16 Sep 1808 : (MISC 4394) : 1 autograph letter signed by Charlotte Botfield, her sister-in-law : 4 pages (double sheet) : from Cheltenham : begins, "I began to think it very long since we had any intelligence from Dover . . . .".

• 9 Jan 1810 : (MISC 4389) : 1 autograph letter signed by "C. A." : 3 pages (double sheet) : from Chesterf[iel]d : begins, "We were very much concerned in receiving a letter last night from Miss M . Benton to hear of your dear mother's serious illness . . . .".

• 26 Mar 1813 : (MISC 4391) : 1 autograph letter signed by Sarah Withering, her husband's aunt : 4 pages (double sheet) : from Norton : begins, "You will I know allow me to be your correspondent when it is inconvenient to Charlotte to write . . . .".
