. To "Dear Sir" : "Wednesday" [circa 1830's] : (MISC 4023.36a) : 1 page (single sheet) : from Bank : begins, "Do you purpose attending the Theatre Royal . . ." Mounted in the Mary Ann Humble Autograph Album. Shelved with oversized manuscript volumes.
