Abstract: Elizabeth Sourtiz was a Russian writer specializing in 19th and early 20th century dance history in Moscow. Her collection holds photographic prints, transparencies, and negatives from her book Soviet Choreographers in the 1920s.

Creator History

Elizabeth Souritz was born in Russia in 1923, and attended the Moscow Theatre Institute. She worked at the Moscow Theatre Museum and Theatre Library and the Institute for Studies in the Arts. Sourtiz is the author of many articles about the history of late 19th and early 20th century Russian dance, as well as the book *Soviet Choreographers in the 1920s*, which was published and translated into English in 1990.

Scope and Content Note

The collection contains photographic prints, transparencies, and negatives that Elizabeth Sourtiz used in her book, *Soviet Choreographers in the 1920s*. The transparencies include some notes and

annotations in both Russian and English. The prints are all numbered, which corresponds to the numbers used in the book captions.
