Historical and Biographical Note

Dance Magazine is a monthly dance publication covering modern dance and ballet, as well as other forms of dance, including jazz, primarily in the United States. The magazine was first published in 1927 and has continued monthly to the present day.

Richard Philp was the Editor –in- Chief of Dance Magazine from 1989 – 1999. His career began at *Dance Magazine* as the Managing Editor, when he was brought to the magazine under William Como's tutelage in 1969. Como was the Editor-in-Chief of Dance Magazine after Lydia Joel's editorship, beginning in 1967 through his death in 1989.

When Como died in 1989, Philp was appointed Editor-in-Chief. He held that position for 11 years. In 1999 under a new publisher, and an office move to the San Francisco area, his role was changed to “executive editor”. In this role he continued to write his monthly *Kickoff* column until 2002.

Scope and Content Note

The Richard Philp's *Dance Magazine* Records document the years 1989-2000 while he was Editor-in-Chief. *Dance Magazine* has had a nearly 80-year run as the preeminent magazine about dance in the United States and the world.

The papers include the administrative and financial records of *Dance Magazine*. Also in the collection are materials about article proposals, writers, and subjects pertinent to dancers. The correspondence is of a professional nature. The materials that chronicle *The Annual Dance Magazine Awards* show the process from nomination through production of the event. The section about Richard Philp mainly concerns his travels throughout the world attending dance performances of the major companies both United States and International. There are no personal materials in the collection.

Series Descriptions

Series I: Correspondence, 1969-1999 **10 boxes**

Arrangement: Alphabetical

This series contains correspondence. The majority of the correspondence is between R. Philp and publishers, writers, dancers, educators, government officials, directors, and photographers. All of the correspondence is of a professional nature, and concern the running of the magazine. There is no personal correspondence in the series.

Series II: Administrative Files, 1981-1999 **6 boxes**

Arrangement: Alphabetical.

This series contains files related to the administrative work of *Dance Magazine*. It includes job descriptions, budgets, layouts, expenses, copyrights, indexes, surveys and schedules. There is also

information about printing, invoices, resumes, reader profiles, staff directories, and subscription information.

Series III: Articles in *Dance Magazine*, 1985-1987 and 1998-1999 10 boxes

Arrangement: Alphabetical and chronological.

This series contains copy-edited versions of articles that appeared in *Dance Magazine*. The group of articles from 1998-1999 are listed alphabetically. The group of articles from 1985-1987 are listed chronologically. The numbering system used at *Dance Magazine* to identify these articles was left intact. This numbering system uses a two digit month, a brief title and the two digit year, as an example: 08vienna86.

Series IV: Subject Files, 1972-1999 35 boxes

Arrangement: Alphabetical

This series contain information about subjects suggested and/or used in special features and articles. There are proposals, copy-edited versions and background information.

Series V: Writers, 1986-1998 1 box

Arrangement: Alphabetical

This series contains information about writers for *Dance Magazine*. Some of the folders contain material previously written for other publications.

Series VI: Dance Magazine Awards, 1955-1998 5 boxes

Arrangement: Chronological

This series contains material about the *Dance Magazine Awards*. Included are the selection process, biographical information about the winners, and information about how the awards ceremony was produced. Also included are guest lists and invitations.

Series VII: Travel by Richard Philp, 1977-1999 6 boxes

Arrangement: Alphabetical

This series contains material about trips that R. Philp participated in as a representative of *Dance Magazine*. The material includes itineraries, tickets, maps, hotel and local travel, tourist places, and programs of events attended.
