Creator History

Dancer and teacher Anita Zahn (1903-1994) was born in Germany. She was a student of Elizabeth Duncan and her technique. Zahn made her home and career in the United States. She died in Grants Pass, Oregon.

Custodial History

Separated from the Anita Zahn Collection (Manuscript accession #96-07).

Scope and Content Note

The collection documents the life and career of dancer and teacher Anita Zahn and spans from circa 1890s to 1990 (bulk dates circa 1920s-1990). Photographs are mostly black and white and include portraits of Zahn and photographs of her dancers and students. Among them are Rosemarie Beenk, Betty Friedman, Kathleen Hinni, Hortense Dolan Kooluris, and Erna Schulz. There are also a number of personal and family photographs, including her parents, husband and son.

Photographers include Kathryn Abbe, Gordon Anthony, Bouchard, Cecil Clevelly, Louis S. Davidson, Friedman-Abeles, Arnold Genthe, Frances McLaughlin-Gill, Gjon Mili, and Clara Sipprell.
