Biographical note

Aleksander Witold Rudzinski was born in Cracow, Poland, March 4, 1900. During Summer 1948, Autum 1948, Summer 1949 and January 1950 Acting Chief of the Polish delegation to the United Nations. From December 1945 until resignation in January 1950 Chief of the Legal Department, Polish Consulate General in New York. He resigned January 16, 1950 in the protest against the Sovetisation of Poland and complete Soviet domination of Polish external and internal affairs.

Scope and content note

The Aleksander and Anna Rudzinski Collection consists of materials dealing with interwar Poland and the early years of emigration to America. The materials reflect the life of Polish Jewish scholars in the field of international law and biology. The collection contains black and white photos of largely unidentified man and women. Among the other subjects are cities, nature, recreation, boats and group photographs. The collection also includes correspondence, documents, papers as well as several articles by Aleksander Rudzinski.
