Harriet (d. 1996) and Kenn Stryker-Rodda (d. 1990) were professional genealogists, lecturers, teachers, and authors of numerous publications in the field.

Scope and content note

Typed and handwritten genealogical research notes, charts, Bible and church records, family documents, and cemetery inscriptions from ca. 17th to 20th century, compiled by Harriet and Kenn Stryker-Rodda and others, relating to several hundred families, primarily from New York State, with a number from Long Island; location files include Brooklyn, New Utrecht and Newtown, New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania.
