Description

William David Lewis (1792-1881) was a merchant and banker, born in Christiana, New Castle County Delaware. He went to Russia, 1818-24, to be in the employ of his brother John D. and during his time there he became fluent in Russian. Lewis returned to the United States, 1824, and married Sarah Claypoole of Philadelphia. Residing in Philadelphia he became an importer and commission merchant. Lewis was Cashier of Girard Bank, 1832-42, in Philadelphia and financed a number of Pennsylvania railroads. He died 1881 on his estate Florence, New Jersey.

The collection consists of <u>Bersonal Correspondence</u> 1818-79;n.d., mainly of invitations to various events and a <u>Diary</u> 1840 Journal of the trial trip of "The Eureka". <u>Other correspondence</u>, 1836-44, re: Stonington Railroad and <u>correspondence</u> re: other railroad systems, 1829-64;n.d. This period covers when Lewis was Cashier of the Girard Bank of Philadelphia. The rest of the collection consists of <u>Financial Papers</u> re railroads 8131-62; <u>Legal Papers</u> re railroads 1841; <u>Charts of the New York</u>, <u>Providence & Boston railroads</u> 1841; <u>Weekly Return of Transportation over the New York</u>, <u>Providence & Boston railroads</u> 1840-42; <u>Printed Material</u>, <u>Graphics and Maps</u>.
