## CHRONOLOGY OF DR. JAN PAPÁNEK

- 1896 Born on 24 October in Brezová pod Bradlom, in present-day Slovakia.
- 1910 Attends secondary school in Jevíčko, Moravia.
- 1915 Conscripted into the army and sent into action on the Italian Front.
- 1917 One of the founders of the Czech and Slovak Legion in Italy. While held in a POW camp, meets Dr. Eduard Beneš.
- 1918 Summoned by M.R. Štefánik to Rome, to act as editor-in-chief of the Slovak section of the magazine *V boj*. Later becomes editor-in-chief of the entire magazine.
- 1919 Returns to Czechoslovakia, and is the founder of the *Office of Assistance for Czechoslovak Legionnaires* in Bratislava. Completes his graduation exams, and in autumn, leaves for Paris to study law at the Sorbonne.
- 1922 Awarded Doctorate of Law, and enters into the diplomatic service of Czechoslovakia.
- 1926 Marries Betka Papánek (b.1900), an American of Czechoslovak heritage, and a graduate of the University of Chicago. Her family also comes from Brezová pod Bradlom. Assigned to the Czechoslovak Embassy in Budapest, but later in the year is transferred to the Czechoslovak Embassy in Washington. Continues his studies.
- 1928 Awarded Doctorate of Law from Charles University, Prague.
- 1932 Returns with Betka Papánek to Prague, where as Secretary to the Parliament, he is a confidante of the Minister for Foreign Affairs, Eduard Beneš.
- 1935 Appointed Czechoslovak Consul in Pittsburgh.
- 1939 Following the German occupation of the Czech lands, and against instructions from the Czech Protectorate government, he refuses to hand over the Consulate to the German authorities. Offers his services to President Dr. Eduard Beneš, who arrives in the U.S.A. in March as a private person. Papánek assumes directorship of the *Československé zahraniční akce* organization in Chicago.
- 1942 In New York, organizes the *Czechoslovak Government Information Service*, which he heads until its closure in 1946. Acts as a representative of the Czechoslovak Red Cross in America. Represents Czechoslovakia in numerous international organizations.
- 1945 As a member of the Czechoslovak delegation, and the de-facto representative of the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Jan Masaryk, Papánek participates in the San Francisco conference which founds the United Nations. Actively involved in the formulation of the United Nations charter.

- 
- 1946 Papánek is named the Permanent Representative of Czechoslovakia to the United Nations, and later as Ambassador Plenipotentiary, with the rank of Minister. He continues to occupy this position until 1950.
- 1948 Following the communist putsch in Czechoslovakia and the death of his friend Jan Masaryk, Papánek requests the United Nations Security Council to investigate the circumstances of Masaryk's demise, and the violation of international law.
- 1948 To 1988, President of the *American Fund for Czechoslovak Refugees*.
- 1948 Member of *Rada Svobodného Československa* (Council of Free Czechoslovakia) in Chicago, member of the *International Association of Lawyers*.
- 1949 To 1950, Honorary Professor at New York University.
- 1950 Serves on the Board of Directors of *American Council of Voluntary Agencies for Foreign Service* (Americká rada dobrovolných agentur pro zahraniční pomoc).
- 1953 To 1970, Chairman and Honorary Vice President of the *International League for Human Rights* (Mezinárodní liga pro lidská práva).
- 1961 Honorary Member of the *Czechoslovak Society of Arts and Sciences* (Československá Společnost pro vědy a umění / SVU).
- 1961 To 1991, author of countless articles, speeches, and radio-broadcasts.
- 1991 Awarded the Order of T.G. Masaryk, First Class by President Václav Havel. Dies on 30 November.
- 1993 The Slavic and Baltic Division and the Manuscripts and Archives Division of The New York Public Library receive the library and papers of Dr. Jan Papánek as a donation from his widow, Betka Papánek.
