The volume also includes source material relating to Benjamin Church: verses occasioned by the detection of Dr. Church's traitorous correspondence, from Rivington's New York Gazetteer, October 19, 1775; and a transcript of an oration delivered by Benjamin Church, March 5, 1773, to commemorate the bloody tragedy of March 1770
