Description David McNeely Stauffer was born on 24 March 1845 to Jacob Stauffer, a lawyer, and Mary Ann Knox McNeely in Richland, Pennsylvania. He attended the Lancaster county schools through high school and took courses at Franklin & Marshall College until his college education was interrupted by service in the Civil War. After being honorably discharged in 1865, Stauffer began his engineering career as a rodman on surveys for the Columbia & Port Deposit Railroad in eastern Pennsylvania. He went on to become a civil engineer of note --by the mid-1870s becoming an assistant chief engineer on the Bound Brook line of the Philadelphia & Reading Railroad in charge of construction of the Delaware Bridge and after 1876 going in to private practice and author of scholarly articles in the field such as "The Use of Compressed Air in Tubular Foundations" (Journal of the Franklin Institute, Nov., 1872), which became a text for engineering schools. In the 1880s he associated himself with the Philadelphia Bridge Works and bought an interest in the Engineering News, which he edited until selling his share in 1907. He was a well-known autograph collector and collector of illustrations in addition to being an artist in his own right who designed book plates and did pen and ink drawings, some of which appeared in Engineering News. In 1907 he published American Engravers Upon Cooper and Steel, a standard work. He married Florence Scribner in 1892 and he died in Yonkers, NY on 5 February 1913.

The collection consists of both personal papers including correspondence with Thomas A. Emmet, Herbert Putnam and Andrew White, a letterbook covering business matters from 1879 through 1882, and other papers and an autograph collection of distinguished historical and literary figures of the 18th and 19th centuries.
