Abstract: Diary kept by Major-General James Wolfe of the British Army while in command of the expedition against Quebec, May 10 to August 7, 1759. The diary describes maneuvering of fleet and troops; conflicts with French and Indians along the St. Lawrence River; differences of opinion in his staff; preparation for attack, etc
