Abstract: Henry Hooper had an undertaking and house furnishings business at Brewster, in Putnum County, New York. Daybook (1863-1865) listing transactions of Henry Hooper's business, including prices of coffins, burials, and furniture; and names of residents with whom he dealt. Contains three bills of A. Knox, who was possibly Hooper's successor
