## Summary

Abstract:	The Aaron Diamond Foundation was a philanthropic foundation in New York City established by Mr. and Mrs. Aaron Diamond for the purpose of serving the public interest. From 1986 until its termination in 1996 the Foundation awarded financial grants to a broad range of charitable and non-profit organizations in various fields including education, bio-medical research, public health, social welfare, human rights, and the performing arts. The Foundation advocated promoting the rights of minorities and women in all areas of social life. Most of the grantee organizations were located in New York City. Only a few grants were made to organizations outside of New York City and State. The philanthropic work of Mrs. Irene Diamond is currently being carried on by The Irene Diamond, Fund, Inc. (375 Park Avenue, N.Y., N.Y. 10152)

### **Historical Note**

The Aaron Diamond Foundation was conceived in 1955 by Aaron and Irene Diamond as a vehicle for personal giving in the public interest. The founders intended to bestow upon the Foundation the bulk of the fortune which Mr. Diamond had been accumulating from his New York City real estate investments. They wanted to give back to the city some of the bounty which it had given to them.

Aaron Diamond was born in the South into a family of eleven children and of modest means. After working his way through Harvard Business School Mr. Diamond was employed for a time in New York City at Macy's and at Abraham & Straus, department stores, before entering the construction business where he accumulated a large fortune as a builder and real estate developer. (One of his proud achievements was the Builders and Decorators building on 58<sup>th</sup> Street and Third Avenue).

His sudden death in April of 1984 prevented him from presiding over the disbursement of the bulk of the Foundation's assets. Before his death, however, he and Mrs. Diamond had begun formulating a plan to activate the foundation and to commence the implementation of its philanthropic goals. Three main areas of concentration and interest were decided upon: minority education, biomedical research, and culture, with a strong emphasis upon helping minorities and women gain greater access to avenues of professional development and accomplishment. To achieve maximum impact the founders determined to limit the duration of the foundation's existence to a period of ten years. This would permit the expenditure of a relatively large sum in a relatively short time, thereby increasing its effect, while at the same time allowing the founders to participate personally in the accomplishment of their goals.

Mrs. Diamond was in her early seventies when she assumed the presidency of the Foundation, but she had already experienced a lengthy and successful career in the motion picture industry. For many years she had been head of the story department at Warner Brothers where she was in charge of examining and identifying scripts for possible production as motion pictures. While working in New York she chanced upon the script of a play entitled "Rick's Bar" which ultimately, and partly upon her urging and insistence, became the celebrated motion picture "Casablanca". In the fall of 1986 under Irene Diamond's stewardship the Foundation began its

operations in earnest. (Earlier, in the period 1982-85, prior to the appointment of a full time executive director and staff, the Foundation had awarded several grants to local organizations). With financial assets of \$150 million the Foundation was quickly identified by charitable and non-profit organizations as a major source of private capital committed to the promotion of the public good. An office suite was leased in a building in mid-town Manhattan to serve as the Foundation's headquarters. A distinguished nine-member board of directors composed of persons of national prominence was gradually put in place, and an executive director, Vincent McGee, was recruited to serve as the organization's chief operations officer. A small staff of administrative assistants including a grants administrator and a program consultant was also hired. By design the staff (eleven persons in all) was kept to a minimum so that decisions could be made quickly and efficiently without bureaucratic delay. In its relations with grantees the Foundation also encouraged direct and straightforward communication free from the customary jargon of supplication. This management style, which favored simplicity and

unpretentiousness in its dealings and arrangements, was adopted deliberately by Irene Diamond and implemented by the executive director.

Vincent McGee brought to the Foundation a strong background of experience in foundation work. At the time of his recruitment he was executive director of the Hunt Alternative Fund and a member of the board of directors of Amnesty International of the U.S.A. Earlier, during the Viet Nam War, he had been named a "prisoner of conscience" by Amnesty International for his refusal on moral grounds to be inducted into the armed services, which resulted in his imprisonment for draft evasion. He appealed, with the help of the American Civil Liberties Union, to the U.S. Supreme Court and was rejected, but he was subsequently pardoned by President Ford. The experience, he avowed, taught him the virtues of patience and humility and was instrumental in shaping his approach to foundation work. During his trial appointment as "consultant", Mr. McGee was largely responsible for developing the infrastructure of administrative procedures and practices required for carrying out the Foundation's mission. In May of 1986 he was duly elected executive director, and subsequently, ex officio member (without voting rights) of the board of directors.

The Foundation's arrival on the urban scene was well-timed. The era of relative abundance of public funds for social and cultural purposes provided by The "Great Society" of the 1960's and its aftermath had all but come to an end. Charitable and non-profit organizations had to rely increasingly upon private giving in meeting the social and cultural needs of their constituents.

The Foundation was one of the first to recognize the need for funds to fight the growing epidemic of AIDS. It funded research projects at many leading centers of medical research into the causes of AIDS and HIV infection including the Albert Einstein College of Medicine, the Mount Sinai Medical Center, the Public Health Research Institute of New York City, and Rockefeller University. The Foundation also established in New York City one of the largest research laboratories in the world devoted entirely to AIDS research, the Aaron Diamond AIDS Research Center. Under the direction of Dr. David Ho (at the time a relatively unknown research scientist chosen personally by Irene Diamond) the Center achieved a major breakthrough in AIDS research with its discovery of protease inhibitors. In other areas the Foundation supported research into the causes of Alzheimer's disease, cancer, leukemia, and cardiovascular diseases with grants to research centers such as Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons, the Long Island Jewish Medical Center, the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center and SUNY's Cardiovascular Research Center at Stony Brook. Despite public controversy the Foundation also funded, at the request of the city's schools chancellor, an AIDS education program in the public schools which offered free condoms to teenagers. In the field of urban education the Foundation supported a multitude of projects and programs designed to raise educational standards and to promote access of all students, including ethnic minorities, immigrants, and the culturally handicapped, to quality education from pre-school to the university. Many of the colleges and professional schools of CUNY (City University of New York) received annual grants for a wide variety of projects and programs including adult and child literacy, peer tutoring, minority teacher training, minority health care internships, human services internships for women students, and student nurse recruitment. CUNY's Law School which instituted a controversial curriculum in public interest law (one of the first law schools in the nation

to do so) also received grant funds for its legal skills development program to help students improve their pass rates on bar examinations. Included among the many other recipients of grants in the field of education were the Bank Street College of Education, Center for Educational Leadership, the Fund for New York City Public Education and the Prospect Center for Educational Research.

In the cultural field, the Foundation was no less active. Libraries, museums, and art galleries also received generous supporting grants as did numerous groups and organizations in the fields of film, public broadcasting, and the performing arts. Among these were the American Ballet Theatre, Ballet Hispanico of New York, Brooklyn Academy of Music, Chamber Music Society of Lincoln Center, City Center, Colden Center for the Performing Arts, Dance Theatre of Harlem, Feld Ballet, the Joffrey Ballet and The Studio Museum in Harlem (the city's only Black fine arts museum). The promotion of the training of promising young artists was one of the Foundation's major concerns.

Numerous human rights and social welfare organizations also received the Foundation's encouragement and financial support. Among the human rights organizations receiving grants were Americas Watch and Asia Watch of the Fund for Free Expression, Amnesty International, Center for Immigrant Rights, Center for the Study of Human Rights (at Columbia University), Central American Legal Assistance, Committee to Protect Journalists, Interlink Press Service, Lambda Legal Defense and Education Fund, Lawyers Committee for Human Rights, and the Legal Action Center. In the field of child and social welfare the Foundation supported a broad range of caring organizations including Advocates for Children of New York, Inc., Association to Benefit Children, Boys Harbor, Inc., Center for Family Life, Child Care, Inc., Children's Health Fund, Community Food Resource Exchange, and Project Reach Youth. Important grants were also awarded to several organizations in other states. These included the Chattanooga Neighborhood Enterprise (Tenn.), Children's Defense Fund (D.C.), Coalition for Essential Schools (R.I.), the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute (Mass.),

Harvard School of Public Health (Mass.), High Scope Education Research Foundation (Mi.), McDowell Colony (N.H.), and The Sundance Institute for Film and Television (Utah).

In carrying out its mission of philanthropy in the public interest the Foundation constantly emphasized the need for equality of opportunity for all members of society. Officers of organizations receiving grant funds were urged to encourage affirmative action on behalf of women and disadvantaged minorities in implementing their projects and programs. The grant agreement required recipients to submit interim progress reports (at six month intervals) and to issue a final report at the end of the term of the grant outlining the work accomplished with the grant funds. Grants were frequently awarded for a term of several years, although funds were disbursed annually. Grant recipients also agreed to accept on-site inspection visits by Foundation staff and to provide access to pertinent financial records relative to the uses which were made of the grant funds. Grants totaling more than \$25,000 were awarded, according to the Foundation's by-laws, by decision of the board of directors. The president of the Foundation, Irene Diamond, had discretionary power to award grants totaling less than that amount.

### **Scope and Content Note**

The bulk of the collection consists of grant files arranged alphabetically by year which record the awarding and administration of financial grants to charitable and non-profit organizations in the fields of medical research, education and culture mainly in New York City who appealed to the Foundation for funds for general support or for special projects and programs. The files include correspondence of the executive director with grantee organizations; copies of proposals and other documents including annual reports, auditors' reports, newsletters and miscellaneous printed matter submitted by grantees in support of their requests for funds; and documents relating to the administration of the grants including grant agreement letters, interim and final reports, internal memoranda, grant data worksheets, and other records. Included also are minutes of the Foundation's board of directors; and miscellaneous records including a chronological file of grant agreement letters sent; and a file of correspondence of the executive director acknowledging and rejecting requests for financial aid.

### **Arrangement Note**

The records are arranged into four series:

I. Grant Files; II. Minutes of the Board of Directors; III. Miscellaneous Records; and IV. Additional Records

### **Series Descriptions**

### SERIES I. GRANT FILES

(CONTAINERS #1-340)

The grant files (1984-96) which comprise the bulk of the records are arranged yearly and then alphabetically within the year by title of the organization receiving grant funds. (Grant recipients were limited to charitable and non-profit organizations as defined by the Internal Revenue Code.) The bulk of the organizations receiving grants were located in New York City (and State). Relatively few grants were made to organizations outside of New York State, principally to organizations in the District of Columbia, Massachusetts, Tennessee, Wisconsin and Utah.

The files include correspondence of the executive director, Vincent McGee, with executive directors, project managers, educators, research scientists, college and university presidents, and other officials and administrators of educational, cultural, health, scientific, and social welfare organizations and institutions mainly in New York City. (A few grants were awarded elsewhere in New York State and in a few other states.) The correspondence relates to the disbursement of financial aid in the form of grants to charitable and non-profit organizations who appealed to the Foundation for funds for general administrative support or for the development and implementation of special projects or programs.

Collateral to the correspondence are proposals and proposal abstracts submitted by grantee organizations in support of their requests for funds. Taken as a whole these documents provide a detailed and comprehensive view of a broad range of social, cultural and public health needs in New York City and the projects, methods and programs which were proposed to deal with them. Annexed to the proposals are various supporting documents including curricular vitae of principal project or program personnel, budget worksheets, and scientific monographs and bibliographies. Included also are interim progress reports and final reports submitted by the grantees in compliance with the grant agreement. These reports assess the achievements of the grant award as well as the difficulties and problems encountered in meeting the proposals' goals and objectives. Included also are internal memoranda and reports made by Foundation staff which analyze and evaluate grantees' proposals and which make recommendations regarding them.

Included also is some correspondence of the executive director with outside referees regarding the evaluation of proposals under consideration; and some routine correspondence of Foundation staff including program officers (Marsha Bonner, Kate Chieco, and Norman Fruchter) and the grant administrator (Ann Williams Gael). The grant files also contain many routine documents relative to the administration of the grants including grant agreement letters signed by an official of the grantee organization which define the terms and conditions of the grant; grant data worksheets which record on-going administrative activities relating to the grants; and payment vouchers which indicate the amounts of funds awarded. Each file also contains copies of correspondence between the grant recipient and the Internal Revenue Service which verify the grantees tax exempt status.

Supplementing the administrative documents *per se* are numerous printed documents issued by, or relating to, the grantee organizations including annual reports, financial statements, auditor's reports, newsletters, press releases, photocopies of press clippings, informational flyers, programs, announcements, brochures, and other publicity materials. *In toto* the grant files provide a rich and comprehensive source of insight into the efforts of charitable and nonprofit organizations in a major metropolitan area to cope with the increasing demands of a complex, multi-ethnic, urban civilization during the latter part of the 20<sup>th</sup> century. The files also document the Foundation's generous and constructive philanthropy which contributed to the satisfaction of a broad range of cultural needs and to the solution of a multitude of pressing educational, social and public health problems in New York City.

# **SERIES II. MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS** (CONTAINERS #341-349)

The minutes of the board of directors which include regular meetings of board members and annual meetings of members of the Foundation, consist of typescript minutes and collateral documents arranged chronologically from the date of the first board meeting on Dec. 14, 1955 until the final meeting on November 21, 1996. Attached to the minutes of the first meeting are the Foundation's original by-laws and certificate of incorporation. Attachments to other minutes include employment and other agreements, statements of assets and liabilities, disclosure statements, waivers, memoranda, and amendments.

The minutes reflect the decisions of the board regarding the approval (or disapproval) of grant proposals submitted to the Foundation by charitable and non-profit organizations for the funding of special projects or programs or for general support. The composition of the board changed through the years and was limited to not less than three or more than nine directors. Founding directors included, in addition to Aaron and Irene Diamond, Bernard Gartlir, Mary Hennessey, Henry Hofheimer, Jr., and Henry Winestine. Other directors serving in subsequent years included Robert L. Bernstein, Noreen Clark, Adrian DeWind, David Dinkins, Peggy Dulany, Marian Wright Edelman, Alfred Gellhorn, Vartan Gregorian, Norman Gross, Peter Kimmelman, Vincent McGee, Charles Mandelbaum, Irving Mark, Jean Diamond Sargent (daughter of Irene Diamond), Martin E. Segal, William H. Shron, and Lewis Thomas.

The early minutes concern mainly the transfer of financial assets from Aaron Diamond to the Foundation and other matters including the setting of organizational goals; the appointment, education and resignation of directors and members; administrative structure; and routine legal matters including amendments to the certificate of incorporation. Beginning in the fall of 1984 and continuing until the last meeting the minutes reflect the discussion of grant proposals submitted by charitable and non-profit organizations for the funding of specific projects in the fields of education, culture and medical research; and other matters including financial strategies for the management of the Foundation's investments.

The minutes of annual meetings contain for each year a detailed set of background documents prepared by staff for the use of directors which include agenda, copies of proposals submitted by grantees; copies of correspondence between Vincent McGee and

the grantee; alphabetical lists of grants approved and rejected; grants committed by the president; lists of grant renewals; and lists of projects funded in the fields of education, culture and medical research docketed with amount of funding approved.

### SERIES III. MISCELLANEOUS RECORDS

(CONTAINERS #350-403)

**A. Miscellaneous and Small Grants** (Containers #350-351). This is an alphabetical file of grants awarded by the Foundation in the period 1982-1985 before it had acquired a full time executive director and staff and had adopted a code of administrative procedures and practices. Some of the files contain documents continuing through the year 1987. At the end of the alphabetical file are a file of "early grants" consisting of a checklist of grantee organizations with records of amounts disbursed; and a file of miscellaneous small grants.

**B. Grant Agreement & Transfer Letters** (Containers #352-361). This is a chronological file (Jan. 1989 – Dec. 1995) of letters sent by the executive director to grantee organizations notifying them of the approval of their grant requests; of the terms and conditions of the grant; and of amounts currently disbursed in their behalf.

**C. Grant Administrator's Files** (Containers #362-363). These files which are arranged chronologically (1988-1996) consist mainly of letters sent by Anne Williams Gael, the grants administrator, to grantee organizations regarding routine matters relative to the administration of the grants. Following the chronological file is a summary of grant commitments for the period 1986-1997 arranged alphabetically with an explanation of program area codes; and a checklist of rejected proposals in the period 1986-1997 with a listing of rejection codes.

**D. Acknowledgements & Rejections File** (Containers #364-398). This file is arranged into three parts. The first part (in Containers #364-386) consists of correspondence in the period 1986-1996 (arranged alphabetically within the year) of the executive director, Vincent McGee, and of the grants administrators with officials of organizations requesting funds for special projects and programs. The incoming letters give brief descriptions of the projects and programs; the outgoing letters indicate that the requests have been received, reviewed, and rejected.

The second part (in Containers #387-394) consists of a chronological file of letters sent (Feb. 1990 – 1995) by the executive director and the grants administrator, Ann Williams Gael, to officials of organizations acknowledging receipt of their proposals, and either requesting additional information regarding them or indicating their rejection. Included in the file are a few letters sent to grantees acknowledging receipt of interim reports or advising them of disbursements made in their behalf.

The third part, (Containers #395-398) entitled *New York Times* Articles Responses, consists of correspondence of the executive director, Vincent McGee, rejecting requests for financial aid from organizations and from private persons who responded to an article

about the Aaron Diamond Foundation published in the *New York Times* on March 24, 1994. The requests were from persons and organization in the United States and abroad especially in Europe, Africa, and India. Included are numerous requests from private persons in Poland. Many of the in-coming letters are in Polish and French. Some of the requests from organizations contain detailed proposals of projects and programs.

**E. Inquiries** (Container #399). This file consists of correspondence of the executive director, Vincent McGee, and of the grants administrator, Ann Williams Gael, with officials of charitable and non-profit organizations mainly in New York City and State but also in other states and abroad making inquiries, requesting information, or submitting preliminary proposals which fell outside of the Foundation's priorities and guidelines for grant funding.

**F. Potential Proposals** (Containers #400-402). This file consists of correspondence arranged alphabetically (mainly in the period 1986-89) of the executive director, Vincent McGee, and staff assistants with officials of educational, charitable and other non-profit organizations exploring the possibility of obtaining grant funding for special project and programs. The files include a high proportion of printed descriptive and informational brochures issued by the organizations.

**G. Audio-Visual, Photographic & Electronic Media** (Container #403). This file consists of a few audio cassettes and color slides submitted by grantee organizations; and a few floppy disks.

### SERIES IV. ADDITIONAL RECORDS

(CONTAINERS #404-521)

The additional records (Containers #404-521) were received by the Library in 1999 and in 2003.

The records received in 1999 (Containers #404-518) consist of grant files for the years 1994, 1995 and 1996; and a file of requests for employment (c1989-1997). The grant files are arranged as described in Series I. (above) and are similar in content. The requests for employment consist of correspondence and resumes sent to Vincent McGee, executive director of the Foundation, from professional persons seeking employment with the Foundation or seeking assistance in obtaining employment elsewhere. **Note: The requests for employment in Containers #516, 517, and 518 are restricted** 

for a period of fifty years or until the year 2053.

The records received in 2003 (Containers #519-521) consist of final grant files (1995-2001) for several grantees; and a file of miscellaneous grantee reports.
