Abstract: Mathew Carey (1760-1839) was an Irish-born American publisher and political economist. Some letters refer to discussions of economics, and there is one circular letter from the Pennsylvania Society for the Promotion of Internal Improvement of the Commonwealth, of which Carey was a member
