Abstract: Receipts and other miscellaneous papers of George D. Fuller, an insurance agent in Norwich, Connecticut, who also served as treasurer of the East Middle Town Street School District, and constable of Norwich. Receipts relate to teacher and custodian salaries and expenditures for maintenance of schools; to the keeping of cattle and oxen; to taxes; and to other personal and professional expenses. Also present are insurance, estate, and land papers
