There also is also an autobiographical article by Raphael Mutombo, and a scrapbook of mounted clippings from the newspaper L'Etoile consisting of the story of Chief Samba-a-Kya-Buta, the founder of the Kinda kingdom, written by Bonaventure Makonga. Also included is a notebook of folktales of the Baluba people, with transcriptions of Baluba sayings that relate childhood retentions of elders' tales, written by Benoit Nyengelle.
