Jesse N. Alexander was the Executive Director of Black and Non-White YMCA Volunteers and Staff, 1969-1981, and Director of the Human Rights Unit of the National YMCA, 1973-1981.

Records of the National Conference of Black and Non-White YMCA Volunteers and Staff include minutes of the board of directors, correspondence, conference reports, membership lists, budgets, and publications. YMCA Human Rights Unit materials include correspondence; affirmative action reports; speeches and historical profiles of black YMCAs prepared for the 125th anniversary celebration of the YMCA; reports on the efforts made by the YMCA regarding equal employment opportunities; reports dealing with the struggles and continued existence of black YMCAs; and publications.
