**Abstract:** The American Theatre Association (1936-1986) was a theatre advocacy group that promoted community theatre and theatre education. The American Theatre Association records hold administrative records, office files, and presidential files from 1947 to 1980.

## **Creator History**

The American Theatre Association was formed in 1936 as the American Educational Theatre Association by a group of privately owned theatres. Recruiting its members from the ranks of teachers, actors, students, and directors, the Association acted as a theatre advocacy group, promoting theatre and theatre education. The group published and disseminated materials for use in children's secondary schools, colleges and universities, and community theatres, pushed for federal funding of theatre education, promoted the touring of educational theatre groups, and worked with the armed forces to develop mutually beneficial theatre programs. The Association also sought to stimulate creative activity and scholarship in educational theatre and supported the art of American Playwriting, pushing for the production of new plays and seeking out appropriate venues.

The group was structured into divisions, committees, and projects. In 1972 the American Educational Theatre Association restructured itself under the name the American Theatre Association. In 1986, the association dissolved, though some independent divisions of the group continue to function today.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The American Theatre Association records hold administrative records, office files, and presidential files that date from 1947 to 1980.

The Administrative Records are a combination of various files from offices and individuals around the country which were collected after the dissolution of the American Theatre Association in 1986. There is correspondence, committee files, conference materials, divisional files, minutes, and project files.

The Office Files are a separate filing system, kept by the association's Washington office. The arrangement is a system unique to the association. Letter and number codes have been provided so the user can see the structure of the filing system and identify patterns and missing files. The system changed slightly from year to year. There is significant overlap between these files and the Administrative Records.

The records hold the papers of two presidents of the Association. The Jack Morrison Presidential Papers (1957) and the Jean Korf Presidential Papers (1979-1980) hold administrative files kept during their respective presidencies. These files often contain complementary material to the Administrative Records.

#### Series I: Administrative Records 1947-1980 (44 boxes)

The Administrative records hold files from multiple sources that have been arranged into subseries. These are affiliates, correspondence, committees, divisions, minutes, and projects. These files, which were gifted over a 20 year period, were initially arranged in this manner during transport. Although the files are not presented in their original order, users should be able to understand the major functions of the association through their use.

#### I.A: Affiliates 1959-1971

The American Theatre Association partnered with many like minded groups for conferences, publications, and information sharing. The Association was especially active with the Speech Association of America and the University Resident Theatre Association. Files hold correspondence, publications, and conference materials. ## I.B: Committees 1947-1980

Committees were the backbone of the Association. Since board members, officers, and other officials were spread across the country, detailed committee correspondence combined with annual meetings at the group's conferences allowed the organization to function smoothly. Major committees, such as the Committee on Standards in Educational Theatre, furthered the Association's academic goals. This Committee published minimum criteria for theater curriculums at various educational levels as well as manuals of operations for schools on the standards. The standards were disseminated to heads of departments for use in obtaining funding and proper support for their programs, including government money and promotion by the Association. Many theater programs suffered from under-funding and a national standard helped plead the case for additional support from each individual University. Other large committees supported the day to day functioning of the Association as a group, such as the Publications Committee, the Awards Committee, the Financial Committee and the Executive Committee. Series I: Administrative Records (cont.)

Sub-series I.E holds records from the various production-oriented divisions which operated under the auspices of the American Theatre Association. Major divisions within the Association were the Children's Theatre Conference, the American College Theatre Festival, and the American Community Theatre Association. While the group maintained control over major divisional decisions, each of the divisions were semiautonomous, with their own directors, committees, and agendas. I.G: Projects 1958-1978

Projects were special on-going work groups committed to various educational theater goals. Among these were the Overseas Touring Project, the Playwrights Project, and the Rare Books Project, which oversaw the publication of rare theater texts in a partnership with the University of Miami.

This sub-series contains correspondence as well as reports, budgetary materials, applications for consideration by universities and playwrights, and some publications.

Of interest are the materials relating to the Overseas Touring Project, which partnered college theater departments from around the country with the United Service Organization to take student productions of musicals and comedies on the road to servicemen in Germany and Italy in the 1950s and 1960s. These files contain detailed reports on each group's progress, production, and six to eight week travels through various bases in Europe. The Overseas Touring materials additionally hold correspondence and financial documents. Alphabetical by subject.

## Series II: Office Files 1955-1972 (20 boxes)

The Office Files are a separate filing system, kept by the association's Washington office. The arrangement is a system unique to the association. The files consist of correspondence relating to projects, committees, and general administration. Letter and number codes have been provided so the user can see the structure of the filing system and identify patterns and missing files. The system changed slightly from year to year. Each folder may contain only a few items, and the files were regularly removed for other purposes or for consolidation. For example, most files from 1955 through 1958 were removed from their initial system and filed under the heading "Through 1958," though some vestiges of the 1955 to 1957 filing system remain. The system underwent a labeling change in 1972, and a change in general order in 1971.
