Abstract: Isadora Bennett (1900-1980) was a publicist specializing in the promotion of American dance, theatre, and music productions. The Isadora Bennett collection of scripts consist of seven scripts from theatre productions staged on Broadway between 1949 and 1957. Some scripts have manuscript annotations. Scripts include *Double in Hearts* by Paul Nathan; *Inherit the Wind* by Jerome Lawrence and Robert E. Lee; *The Mad Woman of Chaillot* (originally *Folle de Chaillot*) by Jean Giraudoux; *Miss Lonelyhearts* by Howard Teichmann; *A Roomful of Roses* by Edith Sommer Soderberg; *The Square Root of Wonderful* by Carson McCullers; and *This is Goggle* by Bentz Plagemann.
