Los Angeles productions include *The Blue Bird* (Studio Theatre, 1997-1998); Charles Ludlam's *Bluebeard* (Hollywood Court Theatre, 1995); *Bremen Freedom* (Odyssey Theatre, 1997); *Pizza Girls* (NOHO Actors' Studio, 1999); and *The Ring and the Book* (Metropole Theatre Works,

1999).

Productions in New York include *Candy & Shelley Go to the Desert* (Bruno Walter Auditorium, 1990); *Come Back to the 5 & Dime, Jimmy Dean, Jimmy Dean* (Peoples Playhouse, 1990); *Guys and Dolls* (John Cranford Adams Playhouse, 1996); *Lesbian Affairs* (WOW Café Theater, ca. 2000); *Pandora* (1990); and *Peggy* (New Dramatists Theater, ca. 1990s). *A Girl's Guide to Chaos* (East Heights Theatre Co., 1992) was produced in Atlanta.
