Abstract: CBS News scripts represent American investigative newsmagazine programs on CBS Broadcasting, Inc. 60 Minutes is the most prominent. Other newsmagazines programs represented include CBS News Special Report with Dan Rather; CBS Reports, and 30 Minutes. The collection, dated from 1982 to 1985, consist of television scripts from the broadcasts.

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Creator History

CBS News scripts represent American investigative newsmagazine programs on CBS Broadcasting, Inc. CBS News Productions a division of CBS News develops investigative newsmagazine and nonfiction programs. The most prominent is 60 Minutes created by Don Hewitt (1922-2009). This production continues to be the longest running investigative newsmagazine show in television history. Other newsmagazines represented include CBS News Special Report with Dan Rather; CBS Reports, and 30 Minutes.

Scope and Content Note

The collection, dated from 1982 to 1985, consists of television transcripts from investigative news magazine shows produced by CBS News Productions. Depending on the format of the show, each transcript can consist of one to four segments. Shows represented include 60 Minutes; 30 Minutes; CBS News Special Report hosted by Dan Rather; CBS News hosted by rotating reporters; CBS Reports; Walter Cronkite's Universe, On the Road with Charles Kuralt; Our Times with Bill Moyers (summer series), and West 57th with Meredith Viera.

Arrangement: The collection is chronological in arrangement.
